Description

3M™ Neutral Cleaner Concentrate 3A is a concentrated product to be diluted and dispensed using the 3M™ Flow Control System Wall Mount Dispenser or the 3M™ Flow Control System Portable Dispenser.

3M™ Neutral Cleaner Concentrate 3H and 3L are concentrated products to be diluted and dispensed using the 3M™ Twist 'n Fill™ Cleaning Chemical Management System.

Improper use or dilution may result in a decrease in product performance, and may increase the risk of health effects.

Ready-to-use neutral cleaner is designed to clean washable hard surfaces.

- 0.5-gallon bottle

Each 0.5-gallon bottle yields 200 ready-to-use gallons. (Dilution ratio 1:414.)

3M™ Neutral Cleaner Concentrate 3H and 3L

- 0.528-gallon bottle
- 6 bottles per case

Each 0.528-gallon bottle yields 207 ready-to-use gallons. (Dilution ratio 1:396.)

General Use Directions

Dispense 3M™ Neutral Cleaner Concentrate 3A with cold water using the 3M™ Flow Control System Wall Mount Dispenser or the 3M™ Flow Control System Portable Dispenser into a buddy jug, 3M™ Easy Scrub Express System bottles, mop bucket or directly into an auto scrubber.

Dispense 3M™ Neutral Cleaner Concentrate 3H and 3L with cold water using the 3M™ Twist 'n Fill™ Cleaning Chemical Management System into a buddy jug, 3M™ Easy Scrub Express System bottles, mop bucket or directly into an auto scrubber.

1. Dust floors using 3M™ Easy Trap Duster.
2. Properly position caution signs for wet floor conditions.
3. Mop floor or scrub using an auto scrubber or floor machine with a 3M™ Red Buffer Pad 5100.
4. Pick up soiled solution with a wet vacuum or tightly wrung mop.
5. No rinsing required.
6. Allow floor to dry. Note: Floors may be slippery when wet.
7. Burnish or spray-buff immediately after cleaning (optional).

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Ready-To-Use: When used as directed and diluted with a 3M chemical dispensing system: Eye or skin exposure not significant enough to require protection.
