General Use Directions

Dispense 3M[™] General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8A using the 3M[™] Flow Control System Wall Mount Dispenser or the 3M[™] Flow Control System Portable Dispenser into a properly labeled container or mop bucket.

Dispense 3M™ General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8H and 8L using the 3M™ Twist 'n Fill™ Cleaning Chemical Management System into a properly labeled container or mop bucket.

- 1. Scrub and dry the surface with a hand pad, cloth or sponge.
- For floors, cleaner may be used with a mop and bucket or auto scrubber. Note: Floors may be slippery when wet.

- 3. Sweep or dust mop the floor using 3M™ Easy Trap Duster.
- 4. Properly locate caution signs for wet floor conditions.
- 5. For light soil, damp mop the floor and allow it to dry.
- For embedded soil, scrub using a swing machine or auto scrubber equipped with the appropriate 3M™ Floor Pad.
- 7. If not using an auto scrubber, pick up dirty solution with a wet vacuum or mop.
- 8. Damp mop with clean solution and let dry. No rinse is required.

Ready-To-Use: When used as directed and diluted with a 3M chemical dispensing system: Eye or skin exposure not significant enough to require protection.
